SRAI WI CLASS EXPERIENCES

Srai Wi translates to "my children" in the Keres language, spoken by the Tamayame. All classes held in our Cultural Classroom. Two-hour advance reservations required for all experiences unless otherwise noted.

DREAM CATCHER
Ages 8 and up
Listen to the story of the dream catcher that has been handed down for generations. Then design and create your own. 90-minute class.

GOURD PAINTING
Ages 5 and up
Learn the history of gourds and its uses. Paint your own creation using dried gourds. One-hour class.

WATERCOLOR
Ages 5 and up
Learn about the artistic process of watercolor. One-hour class.

BASKET MAKING
Ages 13 and up
Learn about the history of basket making and create your own piece to take home. 90-minute class.

TRADITIONS BREAD BAKING
Ages 8 and up
Learn about Pueblo bread as you mix ingredients used in this time-honored tradition. 45 - minute class.
Reservations are required by 8am the day of the activity.

LEATHER HIDE PAINTING
Ages 10 and up
Experience the Native American artistic practice of painting. One-hour class.

LEATHER STAMPING
Ages 10 and up
Learn the history of one of the oldest decorative techniques. Stamp and create your own leather bracelet or key ring One-hour class.

PAINTED PONY
Ages 3 and up
Learn about the Painted Pony Trail. Sit and paint your own ceramic pony to take home. One-hour class.

WEAVING
Ages 5 and up
Learn the history of weaving, and how to weave your own piece of yarn art. One-hour class.

CLAY & CULTURE
Ages 5 and up
Explore the history and traditions of pottery and create your own piece. 90-minute class.
